- Supervise and facilitate curriculum activities and areas to promote positive learning and experiences for the children in a safe and caring environment
- Develop and provide training for ABC staff and volunteers in coordination with ED
- Provide support for parent communication and family/parent nights in coordination with ED
- Complete Student Incident Reports
- Responsible for recording and submitting daily attendance and checking students out in cooperation with the Lead Teacher using Excel spreadsheets
- Maintain responsible and positive discipline policies. Report persistent behavior problems.
- Assist ABC ED in making recommendations for managing students, resolving classroom logistics, distributing daily snack, and administrative tasks as assigned
- Work cooperatively with school staff, administration, volunteers, and program partners.
- Oversees the safe use/care of school district equipment and facilities used by the program (including security of building and students)
