Community and Adult Education

The Board recognizes that education is a lifelong process. Therefore, the District makes its resources available to adults and other non-students within the limits of budget, staff and facilities, provided there is no interference with or impairment of the regular school program. Community school, adult education and other offerings may be developed in cooperation with community representatives, through the Community Education Program, subject to approval and authorization by the Board.

While sanctioned by the Board, it is the intent that the Community Education Program be self-supporting.

The Community Education Program will be administered by the Superintendent or his/her designee.
