## **Taking Office**

At the time of nomination and election or appointment, each trustee shall be a school district elector of the district and a resident of the trustee zone from which nominated and elected, or appointed. To qualify as a candidate, the candidate must have resided in the State of Idaho for six months and in the School District for thirty days.

Each trustee shall qualify and assume office at the annual meeting of the trustee's school district next following the trustee's election, or, if appointed, at the regular meeting of the board of trustees next following such appointment.

An oath of office shall be administered to each trustee, whether elected, re-elected or appointed. The oath may be administered by the clerk, or by a trustee of the district. The records of the district shall show such oath of office to have been taken, by whom the oath was administered and shall be filed with the official records of the district.
