Organization and Classification

The legal name of this District is Teton School District No. 401, Teton County, State of Idaho. The district offices are located at 445 N. Main Street in Driggs, Idaho. The District is classified as:

A K-12 school district giving instruction to pupils in grades k (kindergarten)/one (1) through twelve (12) which is further describe below.

In order to achieve its primary goal of providing each child with the necessary skills and attitudes to become effective citizens, the Board shall exercise the full authority granted to it by the laws of the state of Idaho. Its legal powers, duties and responsibilities are derived from the Idaho Constitution and state statutes and rules. Sources such as the school laws of Idaho, and the rules and regulations of the state board of education delineate the legal powers, duties and responsibilities of the Board.

The Driggs Elementary will have the kindergarten and Early Childhood Development pre-school classes. Driggs Elementary, Tetonia Elementary, and Victor Elementary Schools will have an organizational unit composed of grades one (1) through grades three (3).

Rendevous Elementary School will be an organizational unit composed of grades four (4), and five (5).

Teton Middle School will be an organizational unit composed of grades six (6), seven (7), and eight (8).

Basin Jr./Sr. High School will be an organizational unit composed of grades seven (7), eight (8), nine (9), ten (10), eleven (11), and twelve (12). Basin Jr./Sr. High School is an alternative high school option for students who meet the state criteria for enrollment.

Teton High School will be an organizational unit composed of grades nine (9), ten (10), eleven (11), and twelve (12). Multiple-level offerings may be established to meet the needs of continuous progress and individualized programs for students.

The School District will also offer special instructional services to children who have disabilities which are recognized by provisions in the state law, and in State Department of Education policy.

Subjects taught in the respective schools shall reflect the requirements for accredited schools and the State guidelines.
