The Idaho School District Council Self-Funded Benefit Trust, (formerly the Statewide School Program), has served Idaho school districts for more than 45 years by delivering quality benefit packages and innovative solutions to managing the cost of healthcare. We are pleased to provide another year of lower than trend renewal rates for medical, dental and vision coverage to our participating districts.

Group rate changes effective September 1, 2017 include:

- 2.4 percent self-funded medical rate increase
- No change in self-funded dental rates (for schools with medical coverage)
- 2 percent self-funded dental rate increase for schools without medical coverage. Discount of 2% on dental rates will be given for schools that elect medical coverage effective 9/1/17.
- No change in vision rates (VSP network)
- 2.93 percent increase for fully-insured Dental Blue Connect (with the Willamette network)
- EAP with BPA:
 - 3 visits: 3.5 percent increase
 - 8 visits: 1 percent increase
 - All other visit limits: varying decreases

Our Trustees continue working to ensure that the integrity of the Trust is maintained and that benefits are delivered as promised. Your satisfaction with the benefits provided through the Trust is taken very seriously. Please call or email me to let us know how we can better serve you.
