

Annual Public Forums

The district will conduct a public forum during each spring semester to allow stakeholders an opportunity to receive information regarding the standards and assessments, and provide feedback to the Standards and Assessment Committee. The annual public forum may take place at a regularly scheduled board meeting.

Notice of the annual public forum will be published in a local newspaper of general circulation on two (2) occasions at least one week apart. Notice will also be posted at each school in the district and will be published in the district's newsletter immediately preceding the forum.

During the forum, reports will be given regarding the status of the district's planning and implementation of standards and assessments.

Stakeholders will be invited to make public comment regarding the matters addressed in the reports. The forum chairperson has the right to set reasonable restrictions on the presentation of public input, including, but not limited to, restricting the time period for such comment and accepting written comments. The information received via public input will be considered by the Standards and Assessment Committee.
