The District Technology Plan contains the following policy:

Software/Copyright/Acceptable Use Policies

- 1. No software programs are to be added to any machines without proper licensing.
- 2. No software should be purchased for the network without consulting our contracted technical people. (This will assure proper network operations.)
- 3. No software programs will be added to the network except by the contracted technical people.
- 4. No software will be installed on any school equipment without authorized review and permission. If any personal software is installed and causes any type of malfunction or damage, all repairs will be at the personal expense of the person responsible.
- 5. The School Board approved an Acceptable Use Policy on August 16, 1999. Each school will make the decision as to how they will implement the use of that policy.
- 6. On all school accounts, the district will continue to support the iPrism or other filtering software which blocks out chat rooms and other inappropriate sites. Requests to override the filter will be determined by the building principal.
